Latest News from our INCLUSIVE CHICKEN FARM MACUBENI:

We are very proud and Thankful that Dr Engel, his Wife Mrs Engel, Mrs Braun, Dr Bergandt, Mr Van den Bergh and Mr Ruth came all the way from Germany and Midrand in South Africa to visit our villages of Macubeni and meet the people who are working with us in our Inclusive Chicken Farm Macubeni.

Our excitement started weeks before this great event and in the programm everyone can read that it was packed with items.

Together with 100 members from the different villages of Macubeni, staff members of the Inclusive Chicken Farm Macubeni, staff members of the Home Based Care Program of Utho Ngathi Disability Projects and Utho Ngathi Disability Projects we listened to an exciting speech from Dr Engel, had nice conversations with the Management of Evonik Industries, mingled with community members during the site visit of the Inclusive Chicken Farm, availing the signboard for the official launch of the project and most exciting we visited two persons with disabilities at their homes.

Dr Engel handed over a specialized wheelchair to a young woman who was sitting for 28 years on the floor in her house and has now, with this wheelchair, the opportunity to become part of the communities and all activities within her village.

To complete the information we are now busy growing the next 300 chicken form sales around the 10th of April and we added a house of Layers and getting 30 eggs per day for another valuable addition of good protein for the community members of the villages of Macubeni.
